



SAINT ANTHONY GREEK DANCERS

Set List 1

*Sta Dyo ~ Our little group leads us off with this dance from Epirus.

Souflioutouda ~ A fast-paced dance of Thrace. You will notice how our female dancers hold our hands in a "basket" and dance close together.

Our choreography exaggerates line movements.

 $Baidouska \sim This dance$, performed by our 10-13 year-olds, features a circular sequence of steps believed to resemble battle tactics, and originates from Thrace and Macedonia.

Gaida ~ This dance is named after the instrument "Gaida," a goatskin bagpipe used in Southeastern Europe. You will hear its distinctive sound in our music!

Sousta ~ A couple's dance with origins in the Aegean Islands and Crete in which the couples face each other, executing steps and movements in unison.

Kalamatianos ~ The national dance of Greece! 10 steps but easy to learn, come up and join us!

Set List 2

Hasaposerviko ~ This dance, performed by our little group, originated in Constantinople during the Middle Ages.

Karagouna ~ This dance from Thessaly is one of the most well-known folk dances in Greece. It is performed by our female dancers.

Baidouska ~ This dance, performed by our 10-13 year-olds, features circular sequence of steps believed to resemble battle tactics, and originates from Thrace and Macedonia.

Pentozali ~ Coming from the Greek word Pente "five" and Cretan Greek

Zalos "step," each of our male dancers will have a turn at the front of the line, showcasing acrobatic steps.

Sousta \sim A couple's dance with origins in the Aegean Islands and Crete in which the couples face each other, executing steps and movements in unison.

Kalamatianos ~ The national dance of Greece! 10 steps but easy to learn, come up and join us!

Set List 3

**Hasaposerviko ~ This dance, performed by our little group, originated in Constantinople during the Middle Ages.

Tsamiko ~ Danced by our 10-13 year-olds, this popular folk dance highlights simple but precise steps that emphasize the beat of the music. Joey, the only boy in this group, will be adding his own style and acrobatics to the performance.

Zorba \sim We've taken choreography from the dance in the movie, "Zorba the Greek" (1964). You will recognize the music as soon as you hear it! **Ballos** \sim A lively line dance from the island of Kefalonia that showcases individual couples.


Modern Pentozali ~ We mix contemporary music with traditional dance steps from Crete. The modern version includes both male and female dancers of our older group.
